Nehru Instruction has already been issued to all CDM&PHOs of all districts (Annexure-A) to deploy one Doctor, Dresser and one MPHW to visit the leprosy colonies in his area once in a week to provide all health facilities to persons affected with leprosy including treatment of minor ailments. Accordingly, CDM & PHO, Cuttack is taking necessary steps deploy doctor, dresser and MPHW to visit the leprosy colonies.

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4. To ensure the following services to the eligible cured Leprosy persons within two (02) months:

Providing MCR footwear

Reconstructive surgery, if needed

Physiotherapy services

o MCR footwear are provided free of cost to leprosy affected persons. In 2020-21, total 6283 pairs and in 2021-22 (up to Nov'21) 4881 pairs of MCR footwear have been distributed to leprosy patients free of cost. The distribution position of MCR footwear up-to the end of Nov' 21 is enclosed as **Annexure-E**.

You are therefore requested to ensure the following immediately and comply by 22<sup>nd</sup> Nov. 2021 so that the affidavit can be filed in the Hon, ble High Court. Odisha before due date: -

- 1) Steps to be taken in a time bound manner to complete the Reconstructive Surgery (RCS) of all eligible fit deformity / disability cases of PAL (Persons Affected with Leprosy). All pending backlog cases of RCS must be cleared every month so that there is zero backlog by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022. The month wise plan of RCS should be submitted to State Leprosy Cell.
- 2) MCR footwear (Grade-I & Grade-II) must be provided to all PALs those who require it as per letter No. 514 Dt. 16.11.2021 of DPH (O) in consultation with DSSO of the concerned District.
- 3) A team consisting of a doctor, a dresser and one Para-Medical health worker may be deployed to the nearby leprosy colony once a week for providing

for person affected with leprosy.

Ref: Your Office Letter no- 538 dtd. 25.11,2021

Sir,

With reference to the subject and letter cited above, I am to inform you that the proposal for inclusion of reconstructive surgery procedures for persons affected with leprosy was examined meticulously by the technical committee of SHAS and a meeting was held with the faculty of Plastic surgery of SCB Medical College and Additional Director I/C Leprosy to go through the package master of BSKY to find out if there are similar procedures in the list of available packages under BSKY and suggest additional packages required for RCS for persons affected with Leprosy. The proposed procedures were mapped against the existing packages under BSKY. It was found that all the proposed procedures are there in the package master of BSKY. So, there is no need of any additional package to be included for reconstructive surgeries.

As these procedures have been categorized under different specialties and superspecilaties in the package master such as Orthopedics, General Surgery, Surgical Oncology, in the context of the RCS in persons affected with leprosy the Plastic surgeons/General Surgeons/Orthopedic specialists are allowed to do these surgeries in persons affected with leprosy in private empaneled hospitals.

Beneficiaries need to be tagged to the integrated physiotherapy centers in the DHHs for post-surgery physiotherapy.

Suitable persons with disability due to leprosy may be referred by the CDM&PHO of the district for RCS, so that these cases can be followed up subsequently by the program staff for better outcome.

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
