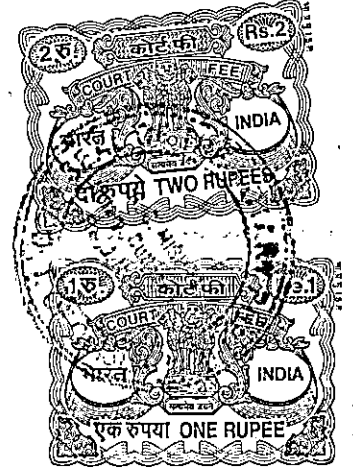
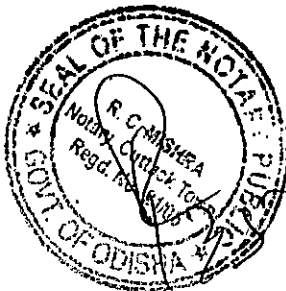
**AFFIDAVIT ON BEHALF OF COLLECTOR &

1. That, I am working as District Social Security Officer, Balasore and have been duly authorised by the Collector, Balasore to swear this Affidavit for and on his behalf.

2. That, the following steps have been taken with regard to the Lewis Leprosy Colony, Bampada

Superintending Engineer, Balasore (R&B) Division -II vide letter No.2926, dt.10.05.2022 has reported that 1st phase construction of ten (10) units Leprosy house with GCI sheet roofing have been completed and already occupied by 10(ten) families. The 2nd phase construction of eight (8) unit Leprosy house with RCC

roof, the roof slab has been casted and finishing work is in progress. After completion, same will be allotted to 08(eight) families. In the 3rd phase, another twelve (12) units of Leprosy house with RCC roof, the bore pile work is in progress.

Photographs of the ongoing construction of the twenty (8 + 12) are filed herewith and annexed as **Annexure – A Series.**

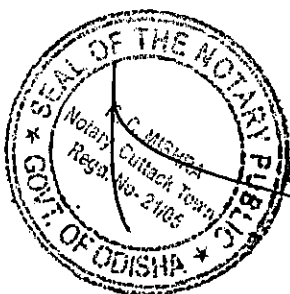
5. That, as per the Resolution dated 23rd February, 2021 of SS&EPD Department, following activities have been taken up:

a) **SURVEY AND IDENTIFICATION:**

Survey of CLPs has been completed at Lewis Leprosy Colony at Bampada. The list of Cured Leprosy Persons has been maintained by the District Leprosy Officer (DLO). Based on this, the data on their family members have been collected. Their children have been identified. Also, the places of their educational institutions have been identified which has helped to cover them under different rehabilitation programmes of the Government.

b) **ASSISTIVE DEVICES:**

- District Leprosy Officer has reported that MCR shoes (Gr-1) have already been

provided to 19 LAPs on 13.8.2019 and Gr-2 MCR shoes to 27 LAPs on 11.3.2022 in Bampada Leprosy colony. It is a continuous process.

Copy of letter No.7108, dtd.10.05.2022 of Addl. District Public Health Officer (Leprosy), Balasore is filed herewith and annexed as **Annexure - B.**

- One assessment camp was organized at Lewis Leprosy Colony with the assistance of DDRC Mayurbhanj on 7.4.2022. It has identified six (6) persons for provision of orthosis and prosthesis and funds for their manufacture has already been placed by the district. Also three (3) CLPs have been provided with wheel chairs and 20 CLPs have been given tricycles and two (2) persons given walking sticks for better mobility.

Photos of distribution of aids and appliances are filed herewith and annexed as **Annexure - C Series.**

c) **ASSISTANCE TO PARENTS:**

- Based on the survey work mentioned above, 10 parents were identified and they have been sanctioned Rs.1000/-per beneficiary per month till their children attain the age of 18.

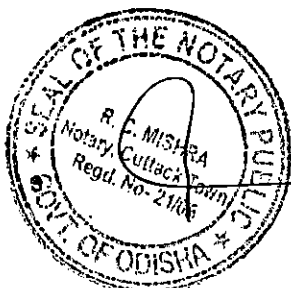

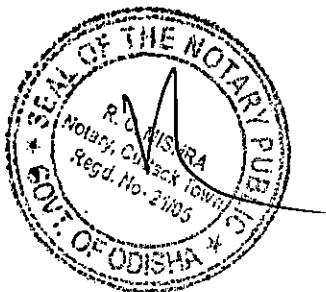
twenty beneficiaries will get training by one Master Craftsman for six months. During the training period, there is a provision of stipend @ Rs.3000/- per month.

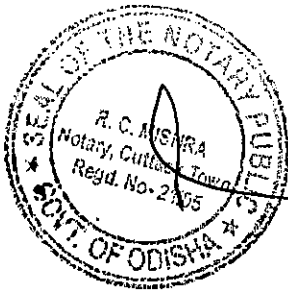

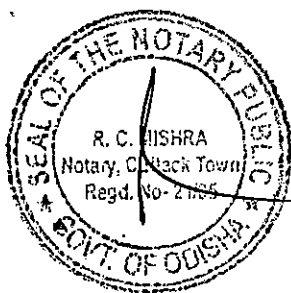
f. **SELF EMPLOYMENT:**

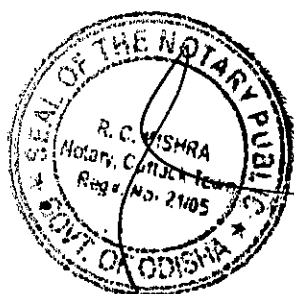
i. **SENTSITIZATION OF WORKERS & ACTIVISTS:**






