

- I, Ms Madhumita Nayak, aged about 50 years, Daughter of Sri Harihar Nayak, at present working as Additional Secretary to Government, Social Security & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (SS & EPD) Department, Odisha, Loka Seva Bhawan, Bhubaneswar, Dist.: Khurda, do hereby solemnly affirm and state as follows:
- 1. That, I am working as Additional Secretary to Government, Social Security & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (SS & EPD) Department, Odisha and have been duly authorised to file this Affidavit on behalf of Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government, Social Security & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (SS & EPD) Department, Odisha

8. The Court accordingly considers it appropriate to direct that a Monitoring Committee (MC) be set up by the SS&EPD Department with its Commissioner-cum-Secretary being the convener of the MC. It will have as its other members, the Addl Chief Secretary of the HFW Department, the Collectors of the concerned districts where these thirteen colonies are located, the District SocialSecurity Officer of the concerned District, and the two ACs viz., Mr. B.P. Tripathy, Advocate and Ms. Pami Rath; Advocate. This is to facilitate implementation of the directions issued by this Court in their true spirit and to ensure that there is tangible improvement in lives of the inmates of the 13 colonies. The MC shall be notified by a separate order to be issued by the SS&EPD Department not later than 31st May, 2022.

3. That, with regard to the directions contained in Paragraph - 8, it is submitted that the Monitoring Committee was constituted vide the SSEPD Department Office Order No.3917/SSEPD, dtd.23.05.2022 (Annexure - A).

4. That, this Hon'ble Court Vide Order dtd. 18.05.2022 in Paragraph – 12 directed as follows:

"xxx xxx xxx

12. The Court urges that the sub-committees set up by the Technical Committee undertake periodic visits in the next two months i.e., June and July, 2022 to the 13 colonies so that there can be tangible improvements in the loves of the inmates there. The MC will need to meet at least twice in June and twice in July for this purpose.

XXX XXX XXX"

5. That, with regard to the directions contained in Paragraph – 12, it is submitted that the sub-committees set up by the Technical Committee were instructed to periodically visit the colonies in both June and July 2022 and track the implementation of different activities. The details of the progress of the activities of the nine districts have been detailed in Annexure – B series.

The 1st meeting of the Monitoring Committee was held on 09.06.2022 and progress on the developments in the 13 colonies was monitored. The proceedings of the meeting dtd.09.06.2022 is filed herewith and annexed as <u>Annexure-C</u>. The subsequent meetings of the Monitoring Committee could not be held in the prescribed time as the Chairman of the Committee i.e., the Additional Chief Secretary remained on leave due to poor health and has not joined till date.



However, in compliance with the Order dtd.18.05.2022, reports received from nine (9) districts on the status of implementation of different sub-components of the Scheme "Rehabilitation of Cured Leprosy Persons" are as follows:

Survey and identification:

As decided in the 1st meeting of the Monitoring Committee, an online database of all Cured Leprosy Persons living in the colony was developed. The database reflects the personal details of Cured Leprosy Persons, the extent of disability and benefits already availed by the individual. As of end of July 2022, details of 5,225 beneficiaries have been recorded in the database. The database could be accessed at https://docs.google.com/spreadsheets/d/1XkdS8Vulp5jBDUdgAgjuJ7o2YovZglCj1I9mrs5g8Y/edit?usp=sharing_eil_se_d_m&ts=62e771c3.

Assistive Devices

- In Bargarh district, 59 beneficiaries of the colony were provided with MCR shoes, similarly, 11 CLPs were provided with Wheel chairs, 3 CLPs with tricycle and 2 CLPs with prosthetic Limbs.
- In Balasore district, 18assistive devices were distributed among the beneficiaries.

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- In Cuttack district, 704 beneficiaries of the colonies were provided with both grades of MCR shoes. Similarly, in a special BBSA camp, 161 CLPs of Gandhipalli and 165 CLPs of Nehrupalli were provided with wheelchairs & tricycles.
- In Jajpur district, 87 beneficiaries of the colony were provided with both grades of MCR shoes and 7 beneficiaries were provided with tricycles for better mobility.
- In **Jharsuguda** district, 10 wheelchairs, 7 tri-cycles and 5 crutches were distributed among the beneficiaries of both the colonies of the district.
- In Khordha district, 64 beneficiaries of Ramakrushnapalli Leprosy Colony have been supplied with MCR shoes & 60 beneficiaries have been identified for the supply of aids and appliances.
- 20 beneficiaries of Jagannath Leprosy Colony of Khordha district have been supplied with MCR shoes and 05 beneficiaries have been identified for the supply of aids and appliances.
- 10 beneficiaries of Bapuji Leprosy Colony of Khordha district have been supplied with MCR shoes and 06 beneficiaries have been identified for the supply of aids and appliances.

- In Mayurbhanj district 38 pairs of MCRs shoes have been provided to the inhabitants of the Saraswati Leprosy colony. In a BBSA camp organized in the colony, 36 tri-cycles, 4 wheelchairs, 18 crutches, 3 hearing aids and 3 walkers were distributed among the beneficiaries.
- In **Puri** district, 112 assistive devices were distributed among the beneficiaries.
- In Sundargrarh district, 62 MCR shoes were distributed among the beneficiaries of the Durgapur-B leprosy Colony. Similarly, in a screening camp, 3 CLPs were identified to receive prostheses from the advanced rehabilitation center.

Assistanceto Parents

In 35 cases financial assistance @ Rs.1000/- per month have been extended in favour of parents of Cured Leprosy Persons in Bargarh, Balasore, Jajpur, Khordha, Mayuirbhanj and Sundargarh. In Cuttack applications have been collected from eligible applicants and are under verification.

Pre Metric Scholarship



Pre Matric Scholarships have been sanctioned in favour of 202 students in the colonies of Bargarh, Balasore, Cuttack, Khordha, Mayurbhanj, Puri and Sundargarh.

Post Matric Scholarships

Post Matric Scholarships have been sanctioned in favour of 49 students in the colonies of Bargarh, Balasore and Puri.

Skill Development Training

161 beneficiaries (Bargarh-31, Cuttack-27, Jajpur-12, Khordha-11, Mayurbhanj-20, Balasore-60) have been identified for coverage under the Skill Development Training Programme in different trades. Skill development training on Mushroom cultivation, Vegetable farming, Weaving and Agarbati making are going on in the colonies of Balasore, Mayurbhanj and Khurda District. 59 beneficiaries are undergoing the above training programme. Except for Puri rest of 5 districts have finalized and approved the programme of Skill development under different trades.

Self-Employment

176 cured leprosy women of Puri were financially assisted with Rs. 10,000 each. Similarly, 34 CLPs of Sundargarh have been identified for self-employment in nursing, Beauty parlour and training. Eligible beneficiaries will be provided with Self Employment Kit or assistance after completion of their Skill Development Training.



Self Help Group

SHGs(Cuttack-27, Jharsuguda- 1, Khordha-4, Mayurbhanj-10, Puri - 2, Balasore-6) have been identified to receive financial assistance @ Rs.50,000/- per group.

Marriage Incentive and support

Leprosy Cured 21 Marriage Incentive Persons(Bargarh - 2, Cuttack-1, Jharsuguda- 1, Khordha-7, Mayurbhanj-10, Puri - 11, Sundargarh - 1, Balasore-1) @ Rs.50,000/- have been sanctioned in favour of beneficiaries living in the colonies.

Living conditions of Cured Leprosy Persons (CLPs) -

Steps have been taken by SSEPD Department by Scheme "Umbrella scheme implementing its Rehabilitation of Cured Leprosy Persons (CLPs) and by Coordinating with Housing & Urban Development Department and Panchayati Raj & Drinking Water Department for allotment of houses and other basic infrastructure i.e. Pucca House, Roads, Drinking Water, Individual Household Latrines, Community toilets, Street Lights, Electricity etc. under Jaga Mission of Housing & Urban Development Department in respect of the following 12 Colonies of 8 and l Colony i.e. Bargarh Leprosy Colony, Districts Jamunda of Bargarh District (Rural area) respectively.



Pension:

Sub-Committees at the district level have been instructed vide letter No.8871/SSEPD, dtd. 23.11.2021 to cover all eligible Cured Leprosy Persons under the Social Security Pension Schemes. To date, 1691beneficiaries living in the 13 Leprosy Colonies have been covered under the Madhu Babu Pension Yojna (MBPY).



Ration Card:

Almost all beneficiaries residing in 13 Leprosy colonies have been provided ration cards under NFSA. Sub-Committees have been instructed Vide letter No.8871/SSEPD, dtd. 23.11.2021to cover all eligible Cured Leprosy Persons within 2 months after they are cured of leprosy.

Jaga Mission:

The Housing & Urban Development Department was approached Vide letter No.4564/SSEPD, dtd. 20.06.2022 to include all 13 colonies under JAGA Mission. In response, H & UD Department has intimated that except for Jamanda, Katapali Leprosy Colony in Baragan under Bargarh district, all 12 Leprosy Colonies of eight (8) districts are coming under Urban jurisdiction and the Colonies have been taken up under Jaga Mission. Initiatives have already been taken up under Jaga Mission to improve their living condition by constructing roads, drains, street lights, electricity, piped water supply, individual toilets, cluster-based toilets, open space development, child play equipment and community centres. The detailed status of work taken up in 12 colonies intimated by DMA-cum-Mission Director, H & UD Department is annexed at Annexure-D.

As reported by DMA-cum-Mission Director, Housing & Urban Development Department, two (2) Leprosy Colonies of Cuttack i.e. Gandhi Palli and NeheruPallihave allready been transformed into Biju Adarsh Colony. Further,

photographs received from districts in this connection are filed herewith and annexed as **Annexure-E**.

As Jamanda, Katapali Leprosy Colony in Baragan under Bargarh district is coming under the jurisdiction of rural area, Principal Secretary, P.R & D.W Department has been requested Vide letter No. 4930/SSEPD, dtd. 05.07.2022 to extend the benefit under Rural Housing scheme, piped water supply, Individual Household Latrine and sanitation etc. to the inmates of the colony. As reported by DSSO, Bargarh, 28 families have availed the benefit of the rural housing scheme in the colony. The detailed list of beneficiaries is filed herewith and annexed as **Annexure-F**.

a. Odisha Livelihood Mission has been approached to curate the schemes available to them and implement them in the colonies. They were also requested to instruct an expert to coordinate with the district officials to check the suitability of the schemes for the CLPs. Meanwhile, Balasore, Mayurbhanj, and Khurda districts have started Development training in Lewis, Jagannath, Ramakrushna, Dharabati and Bapuji Leprosy Colonies. Similarly, in Jharsuguda district 58 families have been covered under livelihood programmes @ Rs. 5000/- per family in the Indira Ashram Leprosy colony. Bargarh, Jajpur and Sundargarh districts have finalized their skill development programmes. However, Cuttack and Puri district are in the process of counselling and

identification of their beneficiaries for the skill development training. Reports submitted by districts in this connection are annexed as **Annexure-B series**.

6. That, this Hon'ble Court vide Order dtd. 30.11.2021 in Paragraph – 16 directed as follows:

"XXX XXX XXX

16. The Court would want to ascertain the views of the State Government of Odisha on adopting the best practices of the State of Maharashtra in drawing up a scheme for the welfare of persons with leprosy or cured of it. Affidavits in this regard be filed before the next date both by the Secretary, Health and Family Welfare Department as well as the Principal Secretary, SSEPD Department.

xxx xxx xxx"

That, with regard to the directions contained in 7. Paragraph - 16, it is submitted that already a scheme "Rehabilitation of Cured Leprosy Persons" has been launched by SSEPD Department in February 2021 with different components of the scheme for persons cured of leprosy having not less than 40% disabilities. Within one year and four months of launching the programme, the benefits extended under the scheme have already been submitted in the earlier paras. Further, Shri Sanjay Kadam, State Commissioner for PwDs, Maharashtra, Dr Arkekar, Joint Maharashtra and (Health), Government of Director

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Shri Koustuv Amte of Maharogi Seva Samiti of Wareral Maharastra were invited to the 4th meeting of the Technical Committee for formulation and monitoring of rehabilitation programmes for cured leprosy persons held on 18.11.2021. It is ascertained during the discussion that in Maharastra every year about 15,000 new cases are detected and the same numbers of persons are also cured during the year and 65% to 75% of persons return home after discharge. 15% to 20% of the remaining prefer to go to NGOs working in the field of rehabilitation programmes. About 15% to 20% of them also end up in the Leprosy colonies. The cost of accommodation per person per month is Rs.3500/-. The State Government of Maharastra provides Rs.2500/- and the remaining is arranged by the concerned NGO.

Based on the above inputs of these experts on rehabilitation of cured leprosy persons in Maharastra, it was decided that the sub-committee constituted at the district level under the Chairmanship of Collector will ensure the following services under the existing Scheme to the eligible Cured Leprosy Persons with not less than 40% disability within two (2) months after completion of their treatment from leprosy:

- a) Homestead land under Basundhara scheme
- b) House under rural housing scheme and Individual Household Latrines.
- c) Providing MCR footwear
- d) Ration card under NFSA scheme



- Reconstructive surgery, if needed e)
- Pension under Madhu Babu Pension Yojna f)
- Physiotherapy services g)

Beneficiaries covered under the above Schemes as reported by districts in 13 Leprosy colonies are filed herewith and annexed as Annexure - G. Minutes of the above State level meeting held on 18.11.2021 is filed herewith and annexed as Annexure-H.

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

a) SURVEY AND IDENTIFICATION:

Survey of CLPs has been completed at Bargaon Leprosy Colony, at Jamurda. The list of Cured Leprosy Persons has been maintained by the District Leprosy Officer (DLO) Based on this, the data on their family members have been collected. Their children have been identified. Also, the places of their educational institutions have been identified which has helped to cover them under different rehabilitation programmes of the Government.

b) ASSISTIVE DEVICES:

- District Leprosy Officer has reported that MCR shoes (Gr-1) have already been provided to (21) LAPs on 13.8.2019 and Gr-2 MCR shoes to (38) LAPs on 11.3.2022 in Bargaon Leprosy Colony It is a continuous process. Copy of letter No.7108, dtd.10.05.2022 of Addl.District Public Health Officer (Leprosy), Bargarh is filed herewith and annexed as Annexure B.
- One assessment camp was organized at Bargaon Leprosy Colony with the assistance of DDRC Sambalpur on 7.4.2022.It has identified six (6) persons

With reference to the above cited letters and subject, it pertinent to mention here that the term Cured Leprosy Person (CLP) means any person who has completed a prescribed course of Multi Drug Therapy (MDT) (6 months for PB/12 months for MB Regimen). Similarly CLPs with Grade-I Disability means Loss of Sensation in Hand & Feet due to damage of peripheral nerve(s), which must not be confused with loss of sensation in the Skin Patches and CLP with Grade-II Disability means Visible Damage or disability like red eye, corneal ulcer or uveitis in eye, lagophthalmos, foot drop, claw hand/toes, wounds or ulcers, loss of tissue due to partial absorption of fingers or toes. The disease burden in Leprosy is primarily CLP having Gr-I & Gr-II disability, who requires regular follow-up and care. The number of such cases in the district is 1677 (in Leprosy Colonies 704 & Outside Leprosy Colonies 973). This is cumulative figure up to 31st March 2022.

G-1 MCR Footwear is recommended for CLPs having anesthetic foot and G-2 MCR Footwear is recommended for persons having anesthetic disfigured/un-even foot. However, this special MCR Footwear is not recommended routinely for all the persons affected with Leprosy. A comfortable, locally available, socially acceptable footwear with soft insole; and tough outer sole with back strap is recommended to those who can afford.

As per the Hon'ble High Court's order dated 18.05.2022 on point-6. Some was mentioned that out of 2346 Cured Leprosy Person (CLP) 360 cases have been provided with MCR footwear. However, the figures themselves seem to be on the basis of data dating back to 2009 & not the latest data.

Figure of 2346 relates to the cumulative information of Cured Leprosy. Person (CLP) residing outside Leprosy Colonies & have successfully completed full course of MDT Treatment from 2009 to 2021-22. The details are attached as Annexure-1.

360nos of MCR Footwear in the year 2021-22were provided to the deserving disabled CLPs residing in different Blocks & Urban areas, outside the colonies of Cuttack district. There are no students identified to avail pre-matric & post matric scholarship for the year'2021-22.

5. Skill Development Training

The Sub-Committee under Technical Committee has visited the Leprosy Colony for counseling of candidated aged between 18-45 years for enrolling them into skill development training programme for wage/self-employment.As a result, 12 no. of candidates had shown their interest for enrolling themselves in the trade Tailoring. - SURVEY AND IDENTIFICATION: a) Survey of CLPs has been completed at Lewis Leprosy Colony at Bampada. The list of Cured Leprosv Persons has been maintained by the District Leprosy Officer (DLO).

SSERD Department

Based on this, the data on their family members have been collected. Their children have been identified. Also, the places of their educational institutions have been identified which has helped to cover them under different rehabilitation programmes of the Government.

b) **ASSISTIVE DEVICES:**

a) SURVEY AND IDENTIFICATION:

Survey of CLPs has been completed at Durgapur-B Leprosy Colony, Malgodam, Rourkela Municipal Corporation (RMC). The list of the Cured Leprosy Persons has been maintained by the District Leprosy Officer (DLO). Based on this, the data on their fsmily members have been collected. Their children have also been identified. Also the children who pursuing their education have been identified which has helped to cover them under different rehabilitation programmes of the Government.



Minutes of 1st Meeting of the Monitoring Committee for implementation of Orders of Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) No. 13403 of 2015 Bipin Bihari Pradhan vrs State and others

The 1st Meeting of the Monitoring Committee, set up under the Chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Health & Family Welfare Department was held on 09.06.2022 at 1.00 PM through Google Meet. List of Members, present is attached at Annexure-A.

Initiating the discussion, Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government, SSEPD Department, the Convenor of the meeting made a power point presentation and highlighted the reports submitted the subcommittees. He also described the benefits extended to the Cured Leprosy Persons (CLPs). He emphasized that Cured Leprosy Persons are one of the 21 categories of disabilities as mentioned in Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016. Accordingly, they are entitled for not less than 4% reservation in employment, 5% reservation in higher educational institutions and all social welfare schemes of the Government including land and housing schemes meant for the PwDs.


The leprosy officer Cutack, H&FW Department informed that Cured Leprosy Persons are provided with 2 pairs of MCR shoes per Annum and instructed all field functionaries to ensure supply of two pairs of MCR shoes annually to all eligible Cured Leprosy Persons.

Advocate Mr. B.P. Tripathy added that there are two types of MCR shoes i.e., Grade-I and Grade-II. Hence, supply of Grade-I and Grade-II shoes should be provided as per requirement. It is observed that Cuttack, has done good job in this sector. The district has provided 342 Grade-I and 219 Grade-II MCR shoes and covered all inmates of two colonies.

The Chairman instructed to develop an online master database of all Cured Leprosy Persons living in the colony in convergence with Health & Family Welfare Department. The database will reflect the personal details of Cured Leprosy Persons, extent of disability, benefits already availed by the individual and their current need. Advocate Shri B.P Tripathy also emphasized the importance of a robust database of all Cured Leprosy Persons for successful implementation of Government Schemes. Advocate Ms. Pami Rath, Amicus Curie proposed that an individual preferably a Cured Leprosy Person in each colony should be identified as a Nodal person/ person of contact in each colony who will be a single point contact to share all information of the colony.

The Chairman urged for universal coverage of all eligible beneficiaries in all subcomponent of the scheme. Cases for Marriage Incentive award pending with all





DSSOs are to be disposed of within next two weeks. The Commissioner-cum-Secretary, SSEPD Department apprised the Committee that H&UD Department has been requested to consider all 13 Colonies under their JAGA MISSION septeme. The Chairman observed that an Official of H&UD Department should be nominated before the 2nd meeting of the Committee to liaison with SSEPD Department on this matter and may be invited to the next meeting to make a detailed presentation.

Advocates Mr. B.P Tripathy & Ms. Pami Rath expressed that individual counselling is required for the Cured Leprosy Persons to select the trade for skill development and livelihood activities. The Chairman agreed with their views and instructed that Odisha Livelihood Mission (OLM) may be approached for curating the schemes available with them. He also instructed that an expert in OLM be consulted before finalizing skill development programmes for Cured Leprosy Persons.

The Sub-Committees need to pay periodic visit to all 13 colonies for individual counselling of inmates of the colonies in consultation with the experts e.g, experts from Lepra India, Mission Shakti and OLM.

Advocate Ms. Pami Rath appreciated the Balasore Model of rehabilitation and urged that this Model should be replicated in all colonies. Elaborating the initiatives in the district, Collector, Balasore informed the Committee that inmates of the colony are trained for weaving, tailoring, mushroom cultivation and personality development with the convergence of the officials of line departments. The Chairman advised concerned DSSOs to visit Balasore and replicate the model in their colonies. He also asked Collector, Balasore to present his model in the next meeting of the Committee.

Both the learned Amicus Curies urged that civil society organisations/experts may be consulted for skill development training of the Cured Leprosy Persons.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair and the participants.





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Proceedings of the 4th Meeting of the Technical Committee for Formulation and Monitoring of Rehabilitation Programmes for Cured Leprosy Persons

The 4th meeting of the Technical Committee for Formulation and Monitoring of Rehabilitation Programmes for Cured Leprosy Persons was held on 18th November 2021 from the Conference Hall of Department of Women & Child Development through Google Meet under the chairmanship of Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Department of SSEPD. The list of members present in the meeting is at Annexure- A. Shri Sanjay Kadam, State Commissioner for PwDs, Maharashtra Shri Koustuv Amte and of Maharogi Seva Samiti of Warora, Maharashtra joined as experts in the virtually through Google Meet along with other members. Representatives from different Leprosy Colonies also participated in the meeting virtually.

Initiating the discussion, the chairman apprised the committee about the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Orissa dt. 03.11.2021 in the WP(C) 13403 of 2015 (Bipini Bihari Pradhan Vrs State of Odisha and others) in the matter of implementation of the National Leprosy Eradication Programme.

Shri Sanjay Kadam, State Commissioner for PwDs, Maharashtra outlined in detail the benefits provided by the Maharashtra Government to the Cured Leprosy Persons in particular and the PwDs in general. He informed that though about 15,000 new leprosy cases are detected in Maharashtra every year. About the same number of patients are also cured during the year and 65% to 75% of the cured persons return home after discharge. 15% to 20% of the remaining prefer to go to NGOs working in the field of rehabilitation of cured leprosy persons. About 15-20% of them also end up in the leprosy colonies. According to the NGOs, the cost of accommodation per month per person in the NGO is Rs. 3,500. The State Government provides Rs. 2,500 and the remaining is arranged by the NGOs either from their own agricultural and other cottage Industrial activities or through CSR funds. He also stressed that each leprosy patient receives a sum of Rs. 8,000 at the time of detection.

Dr Arkekar, Joint Director Health Government of Maharashtra stated that there are 30 leprosy colonies in Maharashtra managed by the State Government. They have appointed dressers in the colonies who are paid Rs. 2,500 per month for less than 50 patients, Rs.3,000 per month for more than 50 patients and Rs. 5,000 per month for more than 100 patients.

Dr Basant Kumar Pradhan, Joint Director (Leprosy) and Honorary Secretary, HKNS stated that in Odisha there are 87 Leprosy Colonies and 8,032 inmates are staying in those colonies as stated by the officers represented from H & FW Department. About 10,000 leprosy cases are reported in a year and about 10,000 patients are also discharged every

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year. However, the posts of doctors and paramedical staff, deployed in the leprosy colonies were abolished over the years. At present there are also no dressers in these colonies.

The Chairman requested the officers of H & FW Department to deploy required numbers of doctors and para medicos on deputation basis to the Leprosy Colonies within 30 days. He also requested H & FW Department to deploy dressers in these colonies immediately.

It was noted that about 3% of the leprosy patients get deformed. Reconstructive surgery is conducted in case of such patients. At present about 163 are in the waiting list. Chairman requested H&FW department to conduct surgery in case of these patients expeditiously. It was felt that inclusion of this under Biju Krushak Kalyan Yojana will expedite such cases.

All the cured leprosy persons with not less than 40% disabilities in the at Balasore, Sambalpur, colonies managed by HKNS Paralakhemundi and Cuttack may be provided with homestead land and a pucca house while ensuring that they can return to their villages.

Shri Umesh Nayak, President, Association for people affected by leprosy requested that homestead land and pucca houses may be provided to the cured leprosy persons. He also requested for increase of Social Security Pension.

Representative from Nehru Palli Leprosy Colony, Cuttack requested that repair of the houses in the colonies may be taken up expeditiously. He also requested that doctors and paramedical staff and dressers may be deployed to the Leprosy Colonies. He proposed that in case there is shortage of staff some inmates of leprosy colonies may be imparted training so that they can work as dressers for the rest inmates in the colonies. Chairman agreed to these suggestions and requested H&FW department may make provision of funds for upkeep of the leprosy colonies.

After detailed discussions, following decisions were taken:

- A sub-committee will be constituted at the district level under the chairmanship of Collector with the following members:
 - a) Additional District Magistrate
 - b) Project Director, DRDA
 - c) District Civil Supplies Officer
 - d) District Social Security Officer
 - e) District Public Health Officer
 - f) Assistant District Public Health Officer, Leprosy- Member Convener

This sub-committee will ensure the following services to the eligible Cured Leprosy Persons with not less than 40% disability within 2 months after completion of their treatment from leprosy and report the same on each month to the State Technical committee:

- TRUE COPY ATTESTED a) Homestead land under Basundhara scheme
 - b) House under rural housing scheme and Individual Household Latrines.

- . c) Providing MCR footwear
 - d) Ration card under NFSA scheme
 - e) Reconstructive surgery, if needed
 - f) Pension under Madhu Babu Pension Yojna
 - g) Physiotherapy services

The Sub-Committee will take personal visits to the leprosy colonies.

(Action -All Districts)

- 2. H&FW Department may consider providing appropriate cash incentives to the newly detected leprosy cases to compensate for loss of livelihood within the next two months.
- 3. H&FW department may deploy doctors and para medical workers on deputation to the colonies on regular basis within 2 weeks.

(Action - H&FW Department)

- 3. H&FW Department may consider inclusion of reconstructive surgery for cured leprosy patients under Biju Swasthya Kalyan Yojana to enable them to get treated in private hospitals within one month.
- 4. HKNS may submit details of Cured Leprosy Persons living in the colonies and stressed that funds from the SSEPD Department shall be allotted for the cured leprosy persons living in the colonies, managed by them. He also advised to take up agricultural and other allied activities by the organisation. HKNS also needs to submit UCs against all funds sanctioned from FY 2018-19 to till date for the maintenance of three Leprosy Homes/Colony at Balasore, Sambalpur and Gajapati districts.

(Action – HKNS)

- 5. SSEPD Department will ensure that pension under Madhubabu Pension Yojana/ National Social Assistance Program is provided to all cured leprosy patients with not less than 40% disability.
- 6. PR & DW Department may ensure that a pucca house is allocated to the cured leprosy patients within 30 days of receipt of their application after their discharge in case their disability is not less than 40%. The patient will need to submit necessary disability certificate in this regard. Collector will ensure that necessary disability certificate is issued to the leprosy patient at the time of his discharge.
- 7. H&UD Department and Revenue Department may ensure reservation for cured leprosy persons as mandated under RPwD Act, 2016 in their relevant schemes and to extend all necessary support to the subcommittee constituted under the chairmanship of Collector.
